Paragraphs	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 1 paragraph per take home (about 8-10 sentences each) • Paragraphs are single spaced • Discuss the significance of this take home message (use the questions below to help guide your response) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Why is this idea important? ○ What is this idea significant or meaningful to you? ○ What will you take away from this particular lesson/discussion? • See example
